

Belvoir High School Uniform

Girls'

Students in Years 7-11 are required to wear school uniform at all times. Form Tutors will make a daily inspection and parents are asked for their full co-operation in ensuring that their children are properly equipped.

Tailored navy jacket with school badge.

Plain white shirt with a stiff collar to button up to the neck (not a polo shirt).

Plain dark grey v-necked sweater or short cardigan may be worn underneath the jacket in cold weather.

Plain black ankle socks or flesh coloured or black tights.

Plain black leather or leather look lace-up or slip-on shoes with low heels (no more than 5cms in height). Boots, trainers or sling back shoes are not permitted.



Belvoir High School kilt (Oakleigh tartan). Kilts should be purchased long enough to allow for growth; those reaching 10cm above the mid-knee will be deemed too short and must be replaced.

Or plain black formal knee-length culottes or shorts.

Or plain black formal trousers, without splits or decoration.

Essential school uniform items can only be purchased from the new school uniform shop. These are the school skirt, jacket, tie and the sports kit. – these items are compulsory for Yr 7 from September 2015. The new school tie will be compulsory for all students to wear from September 2015 and by September 2016 the new jackets and skirts are compulsory for every year group.
