Important Dates

Induction Day

Induction Day

When arriving where you need to go

On the first day, you need to arrive by 8:40am. There will be several staff waiting for you outside. You will be taken to the Main Hall and Miss Steer will be waiting for you to introduce you to your new tutor.

Those travelling by bus on the Induction Day



If you are travelling by bus get to the stop 5 minutes early. The bus driver will be expecting you, and you should show him your bus pass. At the end of the school day, there will be several staff helping you to find the correct bus. They will make sure you get on the bus.
