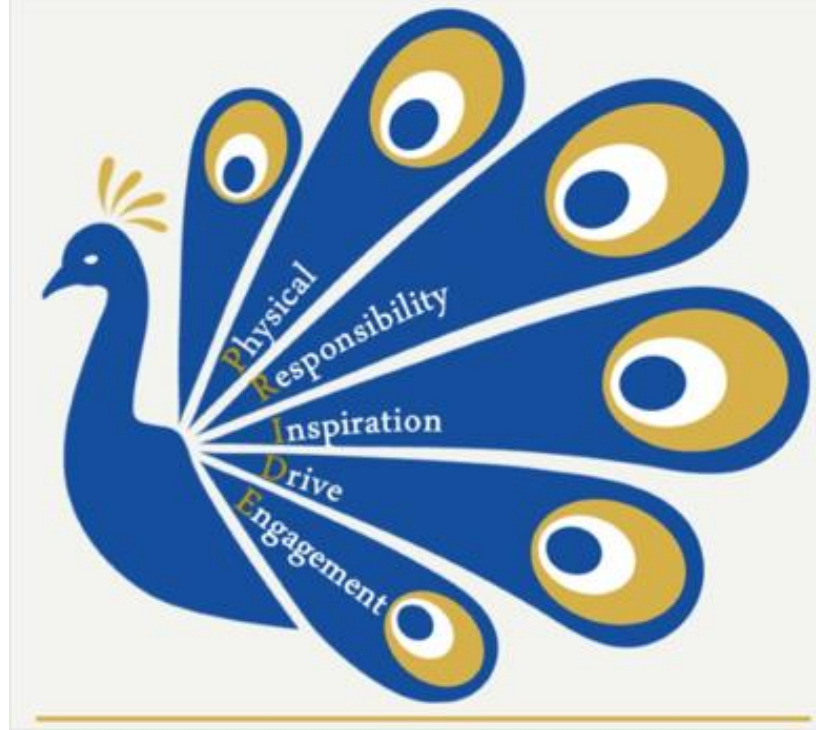


PEACOCK PRIDE REWARDS





- Peacock Pride Rewards are about recognising engagement in a variety of areas and inspiring pupils to venture into pastures new. They are designed to make school an even more enriching experience.
- Our rewards system revolves around the following five values:
 - **Physical** – physical and mental well being
 - **Responsibility** – leadership and support
 - **Inspiration** – creativity and inspiring others
 - **Drive** - being the best you can be all the time
 - **Engagement** - being generous with your time and skills

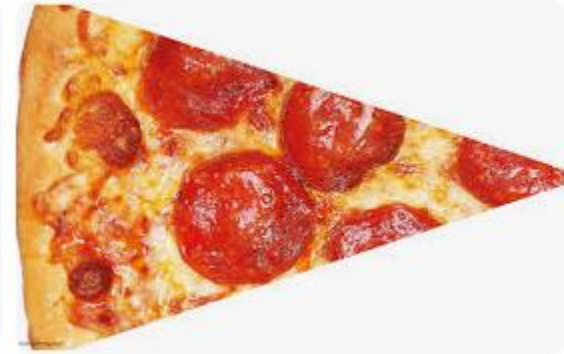


- Pupils are nominated by their teachers for demonstrating talent and commitment to these values.
- In addition to the lesson by lesson achievement points awarded by subject, on a half termly basis, teachers identify students they teach for recognition based on different criteria at different points in the year.
- In a typical year this could be for making a fabulous first impression, for being the best they can be (*a Drive Champion*); great presentation of their work; having a great attitude to learning; taking on responsibilities around school; involvement in extra-curricular activities in school or for simply being a 'good egg'.
- Prizes can vary from something edible, to queue jumps, certificates, breakfast with the Headteacher, or for the older students, a village pass for lunch in the village.

Our House System

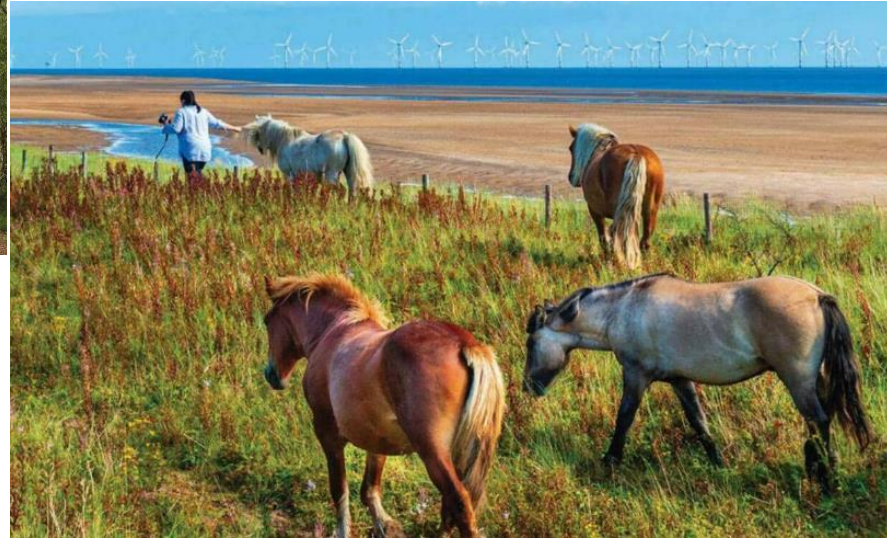
